Five-O Sequencer

- ▶ Detects VC++
 - ▶ Avoids us installing 26+ different VC Redist

Description	Resolution
<input type="checkbox"/> Issues that may affect full package functionality (1)	
 Files excluded from package.	Verify package functionality.
<input type="checkbox"/> Additional information (1)	
 Visual C++ Runtimes detected.	

- ▶ Performance hit when deploying. If not available, it will be installed natively

Virtual Extensions

- ▶ New extensions
 - ▶ Run IExplore and Explorer virtual



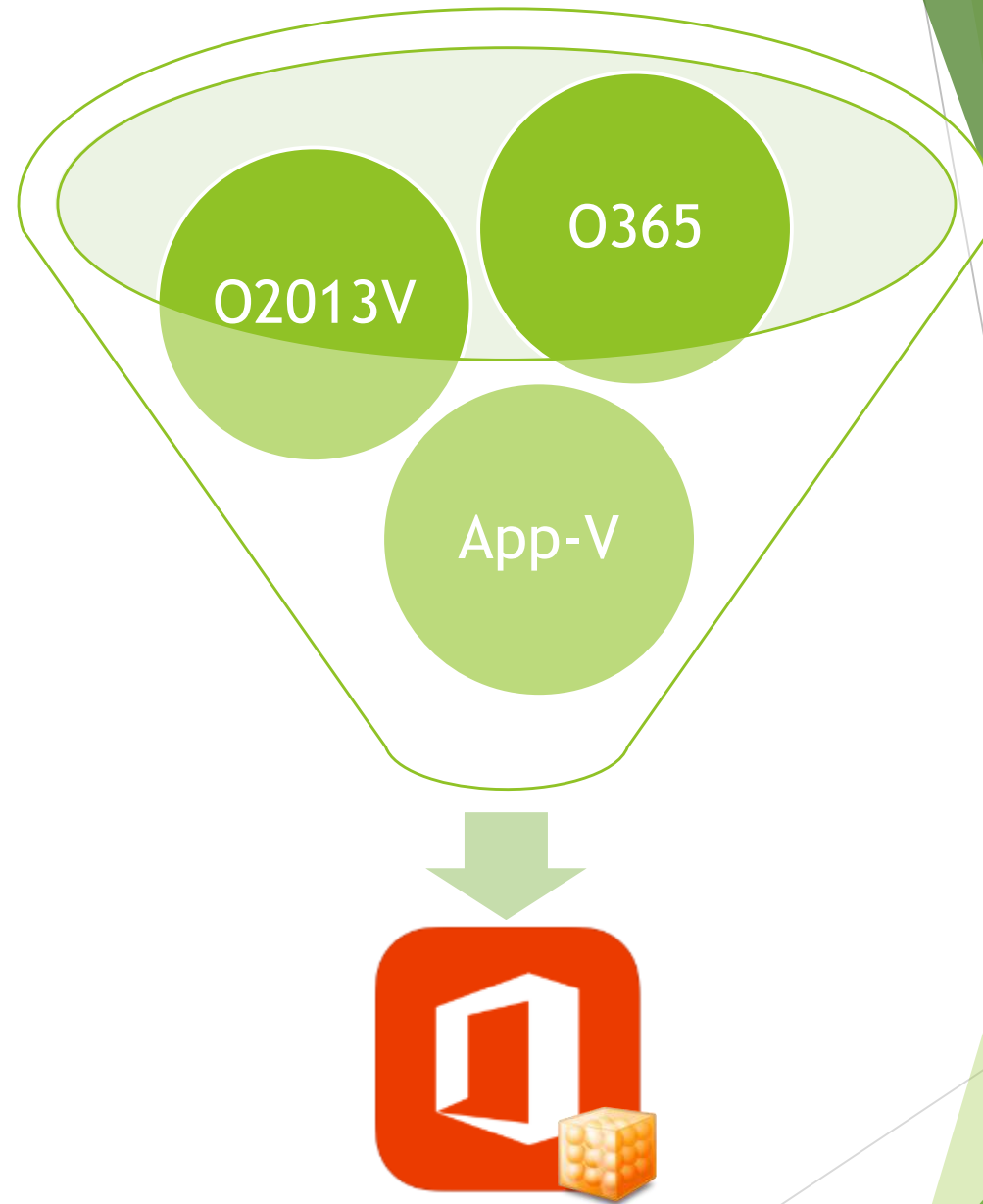

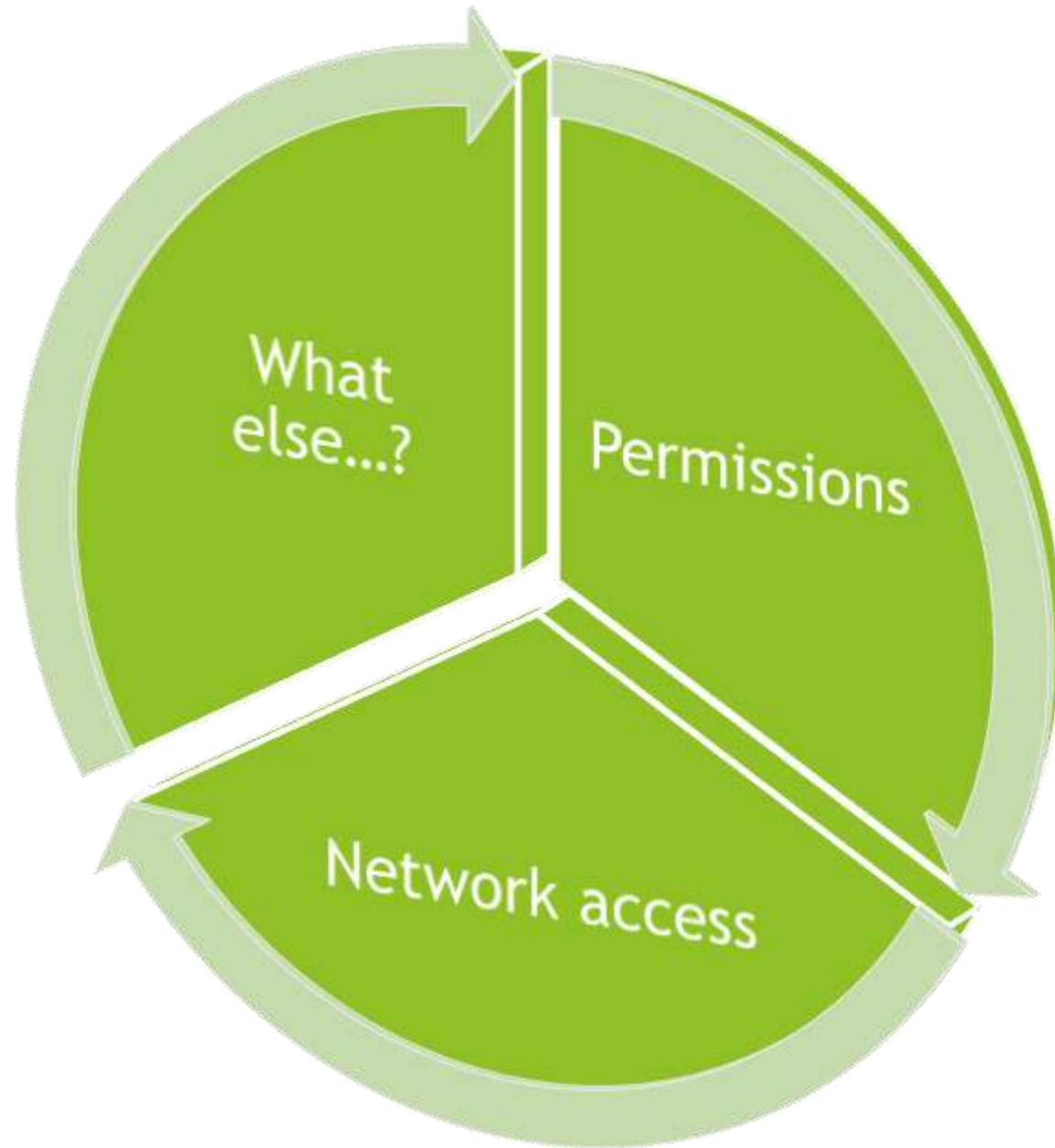
- ▶ Generated PKGs
